- S158 (a) 4d. purple, perf. 14 x 14½, on Esparto. Block with Plate No. 44 18/6
 (b) 8d. blue, perf. 14 x 13½. Block with Plate No. 39 18/6
 (c) 9d. pale sage, perf. 14 x 13½. Block with Plate No. 25 18/6
 (d) 1/- orange-vermilion, perf. 14 x 13½ Esparto. Block with Plate No. 41 40/-
 (f) The following are available as single stamps with Plate number attached. 2½d. (452a) Pl. 17, 6/6; 9d. (458a) Pl. 25 10/-; 1/- 459, Pl. 41 12/6; 1/- 459 Pd 41 (Esparto) 12/6; 1/- 459b (scarce) Pl. 42 30/-; 4d. violet (471a) Pl 20, 8/6; 4d. purple (471b) Pl 44, 8/6; 5d. light blue (486a) Pl 43, 10/-; 8d. red-brown (490) 10/-; 1½d. grey (474 on Pictorial paper) Pl 14, 5/-; also a block of four of the 2d. yellow (475) on Pictorial paper showing portion of the Plate number, 7/6.

OFFICIALS

We do not often offer Officials, for the good reason that we seldom have an opportunity to buy them for stock. We believe them to be, stamp for stamp, scarcer than their opposite numbers in the ordinary sets. They have a legitimate place in any New Zealand collection mint or used and the wise collector will not ignore them.

S178 1907-08 Officials. Specialised Sets.

- (a) A particularly fine lot, mounted on "F. G. Popular" sheets, of Pim's No's 029-036. All stamps are in superb mint blocks except 033 and 036 which are in pairs. Extra shades in blocks are shown of 030(2), 031, 034 and all three types of 030 are represented in blocks. The collection of 64 stamps, catalogued over £17 (Pim's) **£15**
 (b) A fine mint set, comprising one each of No's 029 to 036 plus all types of 030 and extra shades of 031 and 035. The mint set of 12 **£1/10/-**
 (c) Rarity. The very scarce 6d. variety, 033 "imperf. vertically" in pair (Cat. £15). A choice piece for the specialist **£12**
 (d) A fine used set comprising one each of No's 029 to 036 plus all types of 030. First-class condition, set of 10 used **£2**
 (e) A unique used lot. Pairs of 029, 030 (3) and 033; and used blocks of 032, 034, 035 (2/- Milford) and 036 (5/- Mt. Cook). Condition is splendid, especially in the high values. The lot of 3 pairs and 4 blocks is mounted on "F. G. Popular" sheets. Catalogued £8/10/- for singles, this is a real opportunity at **£8**
 (f) Set of 043, 045, 046 in mint blocks. Includes two shades of 043 and 045. The scarce and unusual set will combine splendidly Lot S178 (a) above. The five blocks Cat. £6/12/- **£5/10/-**

Universal Pim's B2; Ditto "Official"; 1d. Dominion (blurred print) B6; ½d. George V. B25; ½d. George V. B26; 1d. F.M. B27; 1d. FM. B30; 1d. Kiwi B31 (invert watermark); 1d. Kiwi B32; 1d. red Geo. VI. B34 (invert watermark); 1½d. brown Geo. VI. B35 (invert watermark). These are all scarce. The eleven mint panes **£10**
 S180 Included in the above set, but also available separately: B31 1d. Kiwi, Single Watermark, Die II. in pane with invert watermark, 10/-; B32 1d. Kiwi, Mult. Watermark, Die III, pane, 7/6; 1½d. brown Geo. VI invert watermark in pane, 50/-.

- S181 1½ Retouch (Plate 20. R8/18).
 We offer a block of 21 stamps, similar to Lot S166 (June), but this time on the coarse (woodpulp) paper. Naturally includes the fine R8/18. The block, mint **5/6**
 S182 1d. Plate 121, Re-entries R10/3 and 10/6.
 See Notes. Probably the best yet in re-entries found in the 1d green. Offered in block of 12, including the plate number **2/6**
