S302 **Centennial Joined-ft Officials (Type 04 Pim's).**

A very fortunate purchase allows us to sell these at a considerable reduction on any previous price. Nevertheless an excellent set. Full set in vertical pairs (except 2½d horizontal strip of 3) of the stamps issued in this form, viz ½d, 1d, 3d, 3d, 4d, 6d, 8d.

S303 **Centennial 7d.**

We have full stocks of this stamp both mint (single or blocks) and used.

(a) mint, each (blocks pro rata) 7/6

(b) fine used, each 7/6

S307 **½d Peace Varieties:** Three blocks in this set, showing re-entry to Kowhai flowers on right of stamp in Row 5, No. 1, on left of stamp Row 7, No. 8 (both blocks of 6 with selvedge) and corner block of 12 with well-known T mark in Row 12 No. 3, all mint. The set 3/6

S308 **George VI 3/- flaws and re-entries:** Here we offer blocks of 12 from the lower left corner of the sheet of Plate 2-1, complete with plate number in each case, in two stages.

(a) showing two flaws in the frame of Row 15/4: on the left leg of the "W" and on the top serif of the "L." Mint, per block 48/-

(b) after re-entry to remove the above flaws: re-entry showing in stamps 14/4 and 15/4 as a thickening of the design in the right-hand panel and "3/-." Mint, per block 48/-

As the outlay of £4/16/- may be rather heavy for the small collector, we offer, as an alternative, blocks of 4 without selvedge, showing in each case

(c) the 2 flaws, Mint, in block of 4 21/-

(d) the 2 re-entries, Mint, in block of 4 21/-

Although we are offering these alternatives we have little hesitation in recommending the larger blocks both for identification of position as a long term investment. Compare the rise in values of the 3/- 1935 Pictorials.

ACCESSORIES

Do not work with inadequate equipment. A few shillings spent on accessories of the right type and of good quality are well repaid in the long run. Especially is this so with hinges. Many a mint stamp has been ruined through using an inferior quality hinge. Insist on nothing but the best in this line.

(a) 1d vermilion. Deep full colour, first-class appearance, four margins, huge at sides, very slight crease	40/-
(b) 1d orange-vermilion. Four wide margins, shows portion of stamp above, light postmark. Very fine	50/-
(c) 2d blue. We have a good stock of these, varying according to condition from 32/6 down to 12/6. No rubbish. Ask for one or more on approval.	
(d) 6d red-brown. Superior copy, 30/-; copy cut rather close one side, 20/-; fine three margin copy with major re-entry	40/-
(e) 6d black-brown. Fine appearance, four margins, small thin spot	22/6
